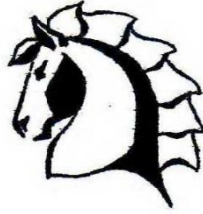
The course will be taught by senior doctors and paramedics, all experienced in the field of pre-hospital equestrian trauma management, and will focus on practical assessment and clinical skills.
