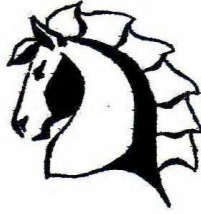

MEA Training ECEQE Course Terms and Conditions

Safety

Participants must obey the instructions of tutors and other responsible persons during the course. Failure to do so may lead to injury.

Usual precautions should be taken with needles and other sharps. Any injury should be reported to the Course organizers as soon as possible. Injury with contaminated needles will probably require a trip to the local emergency department.

Participants should inform MEA Training if they have any previous injuries or other ailments that may prevent them from participating fully in the course, prior to the start of the course.

Payment

Payment is expected in full at least two weeks prior to the start of the course. Please note that until payment has been received that a no place will be confirmed for the course.

Payment may be taken later than this at the discretion of MEA Training

Non-payment: "Bounced" cheques will incur a fee of £10.

The reduced fee of £50.00 is only for those who attend the MEA Conference on Saturday 18th November.

Cancellation

Participants will be refunded the full cost of the course if MEA Training are informed of cancellation at least 6 weeks prior to the course that a participant is booked on.

If MEA Training is informed of cancellation 2-6 weeks prior to the course a participant is booked on, then the participant can choose whether to have half the fee refunded with no other obligation, or to transfer their booking to the next available course with no refund for the course they are presently booked on, but also without penalty. This is subject to availability.

If MEA Training is informed of cancellation less than 2 weeks prior to the course, no fees will be refunded.

MEA Training reserves the right to cancel a course at short notice. If we decide to cancel a course at short notice we will offer a full refund of the course fee. We will not be responsible for any travel costs associated with booking onto the course.

Participation

All participants will be expected to take an active part during the courses and to lead moulages and other practices.
